

Ultherapy Post Treatment Instructions

Immediately after ultherapy treatment:

- Contours: Slight lifting and toning with minor swelling.
- Sensation: Skin may feel tighter, slightly tender, and possibly some tingling and numbness.
- Texture: Skin may exhibit lines of superficial "cat scratch-like" swelling.
- Color: Skin may exhibit redness and possibly some minor bruising.

First week post-treatment:

- Contours: Slight lifting and toning with minor swelling.
- Sensation: Skin feels tighter, slightly tender, tingling and possible numbness.
- Texture: Skin exhibits slight plumping of fine lines.
- Color: Skin may exhibit minor bruising.

30 days post-treatment:

- Contours: Slight lifting and toning.
- Sensation: Skin feels tighter, slightly tender, tingling and possible numbness.
 - o Skin is more receptive to make-up coverage.
- Texture: skin exhibits a smoother texture.
- Color: skin is brighter and more even toned.

60 days post-treatment:

- Contours: Additional lifting and toning for a more youthful shape.
 - o If brows were treated:
 - Brow elevation (overall or outer portion) for a more "open" look to the eye.
 - Less hooding of the lid/more lid showing.
- Sensation: Skin feels tighter, more toned, softer and smoother.
- Texture: Skin shows a reduced "crepe paper-like" texture.
- Color: Skin looks brighter and more even toned.

90 days and beyond post-treatment:

- Contour: Additional lifting and toning for a more youthful shape.
 - o If brows were treated:
 - Brow elevation (overall or outer portion) for a more "open" look to the eye. Less hooding of the lid/more lid showing.
 - o If chin was treated:
 - Reduced sagging under chin.
- Sensation: Skin feels tighter, thicker/more cushioned; more toned, softer and smoother.
- Texture: Skin shows a reduced "crepe paper-like" texture.
- Color: Skin looks brighter and more even toned.
